e. COVID Incident at the school- 1 Pm VCH called the teacher directly a student in her class tested positive for Covid

VCH determined no close contact so no need to self-isolate the class Transmission did not happen at the school

Teacher then spoke to Jason Lauzon

Vancouver school Board then sent out a letter to all parents and guardians same day and to specific students

This morning (Thursday) teachers met with Jason Lauzon

f. School is spraying all students hands upon arrival and most students wear a mask at all times even in the classroom where they are not required.

g. Question about accelerated learning: Stress on teachers and students to complete a course in 10 weeks rather than 10 months

Recognize this shift is stressful to all those involved
